

In the Rheinhessen orchards, between Bingen and Ingleheim, is the Rheinweelle pool complex, with an ample amount of parking space outside.

The Rheinweelle complex includes: a lazy river, a small children's pool, a sports pool, a training pool, an outdoor saltwater pool, a summer time bio-pond, and a 94 meter long giant slide.



The Lazy River

In the main lobby of the complex, there is a shop where you can buy swim equipment,

pool toys, and other swimming related items.

Once you have paid the admission price at the front desk, you are given a bracelet. If you wish to use one of the lockers located in the changing rooms, you place your bracelet against a pad on the locker door. You are then able to remove the locker key and stow your possessions safely away.

Apart from the excellent pool facilities, there is a sauna world, for a sauna session is a must.

Indoors you will find a Finnish sauna of 90 degrees and a low temperature sauna of 60 degrees Celsius at a relative humidity of 30-40%, and a steam room. You can cool off with ice from ice fountains, a diving pool, and cleansing showers.

Outdoors, complete with a large natural pond, a 100 degree sauna infusion, a 80 degree panorama sauna and a 70 degree sauna meditation. A sauna garden, with sun and rest areas where you can relax in the summer.

In the complex, there is a sauna bar and restaurant, from which you can buy food and drink. Sauna users are provided plastic chips that they are able to charge their purchases on, when later paying full price at the front desk. Part of the dining area is accessible from outside for non-pool visitors.

After having a fun day at the pool, drop your bracelet off at the exit gate into the built in bin. Make sure to check for outstanding fees in case you stayed overtime.
