MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the USAG Wiesbaden Community

SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter 12, Single Soldier Housing (SSH)/ Troop Billets Visitation Policy

1. References: Installation Management Command-Europe Region, First Sergeants Barracks Initiative Standard Operating Procedure (March 2009).
2. Purpose: To establish policy and guidance for guests and visitation in SSH, defined as any building utilized as troop billets.
3. Applicability: This policy applies to all Soldiers residing in US Army Garrison Wiesbaden's footprint.
4. Policy The Single Soldiers Quarters is the Unaccompanied Soldier's home and will be treated with the same respect for individual rights and privacy afforded to Soldiers of same grade in Family housing. Soldiers may have visitors of either gender. When room is occupied by more than one Soldier, a Soldier's right to privacy takes priority over visitation. Visiting hours are from 0600 to 2400hrs. Soldiers are directly responsible for the conduct of their guest. It is the policy of the USAG Wiesbaden that no guest under the age of sixteen (16) years will be permitted in any room or common area of SSH. Overnight guest are prohibited. Any violation of this policy will be subject to punishment under Article 92 of the UCMJ. Unit leaders will ensure unaccompanied personnel residing in SSH are informed of this policy as well as ensure compliance.
