SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter 3, Equal Opportunity Complaints

1. Reference AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, 11 February 2009.
2. Applicability. This policy applies to all commands, organizations, activities and agencies regardless of location, as well as Family members, civilian employees and contract personnel.
3. Policy:
 - a. I want all Soldiers and their Family members to know that their equal opportunity complaints will be addressed in a prompt, professional manner regardless of race, color, gender, religion or national origin. I also want to emphasize that I will not tolerate any acts of reprisal or attempt to discourage the filing of an EO complaint. Any commander or agency receiving an equal opportunity complaint will immediately contact their unit EO advisor for guidance and assistance.
 - b. If you believe you have an EO complaint, the best way to resolve your complaint is to inform the alleged offender that the unwanted behavior must stop. If this action fails, inform your chain of command to afford them the opportunity to resolve this issue. Although I strongly encourage the processing of EO complaints through the chain of command, other channels are available. If you have a complaint against your chain of command, use the next higher echelon in the chain of command, your EO advisor, the Inspector General's office, the Provost Marshal's office, or the Chaplain's office.
