SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Wiesbaden Command Policy 30, Unaccompanied Housing During Redeployment

1. Reference:

- a. AR 420-1, Army Facilities Management, 12 February 2008.
- b. AE Supplement 1 to AR 420-1, Army Facilities Management, 28 April 2008.

2. Redeploying Soldiers assigned to barracks rooms or diverted Family housing are not authorized temporary living allowance (TLA). They will remain in their room until their departure date.

3. Redeploying personnel who are authorized to live off post (single SFC and above) but do not currently have lodging arrangements, will be temporarily lodged in diverted Family housing while seeking off post lodging. They will not be entitled to TLA unless we are unable to provide adequate lodging and as specified below.

4. Soldiers sharing accommodations in diverted Family housing will be categorized by normal grade bands within the same housing unit. The senior occupant is designated as housing coordinator for that unit and oversees the sharing of responsibilities for cleanliness and care of common areas. The grade bands are:

- a. Field Grade: MAJ-COL and CW3-CW5 can be mixed.
- b. Company Grade: 2LT-CPT and WO1-CW2 can be mixed.
- c. Senior Enlisted: SGM and CSM can be mixed.
- d. Senior Enlisted: SFC-1SG can be mixed.
- e. Junior Enlisted: SGT-SSG can be mixed (all this band are authorized barracks population).
- f. Junior Enlisted: PVT-SPC can be mixed (all this band are authorized barracks population).

5. We will not mix gender in the same housing unit.
6. If Soldiers who currently occupy diverted Family housing unanimously agree that they desire to remain with their current roommates, they will be authorized to do so and not required to move. If any party non-concurs, all occupants will be reassigned to rooms according to the grade bands.
7. The Director of Public Works will ensure that individual bedrooms have locking doors and will manage key control and room inventory. The occupant is responsible for the contents and condition of their room and will be held responsible for damage or loss when vacating the room.
8. Every attempt will be made to house requested individuals together based on unit request, but this may vary based on occupancy requirements to achieve maximum utilization as described above.
9. If we exhaust our available inventory of barracks space or diverted housing units, or are otherwise unable to provide a room based on the limitation I have laid out in this policy, I will authorize TLA for hotel lodging.
10. There may be some cases where TLA makes sense in a special case or is more convenient to the government. Requests for exception should be routed through DPW Housing to me for approval.
