MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: USAG Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter 4, Authorized Location for Selling of Privately Owned Vehicles in the USAG Wiesbaden Community

1. References:

- a. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, 22 May 2006.
- b. AR 215-1, Military Morale, Welfare and Recreation Programs and Non-appropriated Fund Instrumentalities, 31 July 2007.
- c. AER 190-1, Driver and Vehicle Requirements and the Installation Traffic Code for U.S. Forces in Germany, 4 February 2009.
- d. AER 600-1, Regulated Activities in Europe, 30 November 2007.

2. Purpose: To outline the USAG Wiesbaden policy for the selling of Privately Owned Vehicles (POVs) in the Wiesbaden community.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all military and civilian personnel assigned, attached and/or living in this community. Failure to follow the procedures outlined in this policy can result in the removal of the vehicle from USAG Wiesbaden installations at the owner's expense.

4. Guidance: All issues regarding selling, buying and registration of POVs are handled by the Directorate of Emergency Services. Personnel desiring to speak with a customer service representative can contact the Vehicle Registration Office at DSN 337-7819 for any questions regarding POVs.

5. Procedures:

a. Overnight parking of a POV with a FOR SALE sign is prohibited on any USAG Wiesbaden installation. The exceptions to this rule are if the vehicle is parked at the owner's residence (Family quarters, or barracks) or if the vehicle is properly registered to park in the USAG Wiesbaden re-sale lot.

b. POVs with a FOR SALE sign displayed are only authorized to park on the installation if the individual selling it is using it to get to and from work. Law enforcement personnel will identify vehicles in prohibited areas that have not been moved in 24 hours.

c. The USAG Wiesbaden re-sale lot, located at the Commissary, is the only place overnight parking of for sale vehicles is authorized. All individuals that wish to use the USAG Wiesbaden re-sale lot to sell a POV must be approved and registered with the Directorate of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR) and comply with all the rules of the re-sale lot.

d. The vehicle owner wishing to sell his/her vehicle will display a valid re-sale lot permit obtained from the Auto Skills Center in the windshield.

e. The owner must also sign a statement of waiver that DFMWR is not responsible for the loss or damage to the vehicle.

f. The owner must maintain valid registration for the vehicle for the duration the vehicle is in the lot.

g. Failure to comply with this command policy will result in the impoundment of the vehicle by the Wiesbaden Military Police at the owner's expense.
