MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter 42, Single Soldier Housing and Unaccompanied Personnel Housing Visitation

1. Reference Pamphlet, HQ, US Army Installation Command, Europe Region, March 2009, subject: First Sergeant's Barracks Program Standard Operating Procedure.
2. Purpose: To establish policy and guidance for guests and visitation in single Soldier housing (SSH) and unaccompanied personnel housing (UPH), which is defined as any US government controlled building utilized as a housing residence for single or unaccompanied Soldiers, including Family housing facilities diverted or converted to SSH.
3. Applicability. This policy applies to all Soldiers assigned to or residing in the US Army Garrison Wiesbaden area of responsibility.
4. Background. SSH is the unaccompanied Soldier's home and will be treated with the same respect for individual rights and privacy afforded to Soldiers of the same grade residing in Army Family housing.
5. Policy. Soldiers may have visitors of either gender. When a room is occupied by more than one Soldier, a Soldier's right to privacy takes priority over a Soldier's right to visitation. Either occupant of a shared room may state that they do not agree to presence of a visitor, and the visitor must leave. Visiting hours are from 0600 to 2400. Soldiers are directly responsible for the conduct of their guest. No guest under the age of eighteen years will be permitted in any room of SSH or any common area unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Overnight guests are prohibited. Any violation of this policy will be subject to punishment under Article 92 of the UCMJ.
6. Responsibilities: Unit leaders will ensure unaccompanied personnel residing in SSH are informed of this policy and comply with it.
